DECLARATION OF ELIGIBILITY BY A BODY CORPORATE

Please read these notes and refer to them as necessary when completing this form:

Write in black ink using BLOCK CAPITALS, and tick boxes where appropriate.

1. A share can be owned jointly by no more than five persons.
 2. For the purposes of registration, the property in the ship is divided into 64 shares.
 3. A ship is entitled to be registered on the Register of Ships if the majority interest (i.e. 33 shares) is owned by persons qualified to be owners of a ship registered in Gibraltar:
 - a. Bodies corporate incorporated in an European Economic Area State or EU Member State and having appointed a representative person;
 - b. Bodies corporate incorporated under the Law of Gibraltar and having their principle place of business in Gibraltar or having appointed a representative person;
 - c. A Foreign Maritime Entity.
 4. Joint owners of a share must all be qualified persons for that share to count towards the 33 shares required for majority interest.
 5. Any number of persons may be registered as joint owners of a ship or of any share in or any part of the ship, but any such joint owner is not entitled to dispose of that interest in severalty.
- ◆ **Representative Person**
1. If the owners making up the majority interest is resident in Gibraltar, a representative person must be appointed. A body corporate shall be treated as resident if it has a place of business in Gibraltar.
 2. A representative person is either an individual resident(†)in and having a principal place of business in Gibraltar or is a body corporate incorporated or registered under the Laws of Gibraltar and having its principal place of business in Gibraltar and having as a part of its business acting as a representative person.
 3. The representative person must consent to his appointment in writing. Any changes of name, address or representative person must be communicated to the Registrar within seven days of such.
- ◆ If the vessel is registered abroad you must take all reasonable steps to remove the vessel from the foreign register before completing registration. Failure to comply with this requirement can result in a fine.

- d) The ship is entitled to be Registered and it is not a ship to which section 14(2) of the Act applies and it is not a prohibited ship by virtue of Regulation 16 or a Notice made thereunder.
- e) The Body Corporate / Legal Entity / Foreign Maritime Entity* is entitled to be registered as the Owner of the ship as specified in Section 1 of this form.
- f) The general description of the ship contained in this form as specified in Section 1 and in greater detail in the Application to Register a Ship Form attached to this declaration is correct.
- g) The Representative Person specified in Section 5 has consented to act in that capacity in respect of the Owner.
- h) The Responsible Individual specified in Section 6 has consented to act in that capacity in respect of the ship and is competent to do so.
- i) The Registered Agent specified in the Application to Register a Ship Form attached to this declaration has consented to act in that capacity in respect of the ship.
- j) The consent of any owner who is not an eligible owner of the ship to the registration in Gibraltar has been obtained and it is attached to this declaration.
- k) The consent of each mortgagee (if any) of the ship to the registration in Gibraltar has been obtained and it is attached to this declaration.
