**Shipping Guidance Notice – 072**

**MARPOL Annex VI, Regulation 22A - Collection and reporting of ship fuel oil consumption data**

To: Ship Owners, Operators, Master's, Classification Societies and Recognised Organisations

MARPOL 2016 Amendment (70th) / Annex VI / Reg. 22A

The aim of this notice is to provide guidance in respect of the Gibraltar Maritime Administration's requirements for the collection and reporting of ship fuel oil consumption data as required by MARPOL Annex VI, Regulation 22A which entered into force as from 01 March 2018, applicable to ships of 5000 gross tons and above, as from calendar year 2019.

Gibraltar Maritime Administration will authorize its Recognized Organizations (RO) to act on behalf of the Administration in relation to the collection of required data and certification in respect of the requirement.

Certification under MARPOL VI, Regulation 22A comprises the following activities:

- I. Review the SEEMP to confirm that Part II includes a description of the methodology that will be used to collect the data required by regulation 22A.1 not later than 31 December 2018.
- II. Verify fuel oil consumption data for the calendar year (initial year starts on 1 January 2019) and, upon satisfactory review based on resolution MEPC.292(71), 2017 Guidelines for Administration verification of ship fuel oil consumption data, issue the Statement of Compliance.
- III. Report results of the verification to the IMO Ship Fuel Oil Consumption Database (copy of report will be provided to the Administration) based on resolution MEPC.293(71), 2017 Guidelines for the development and management of the IMO Ship Fuel Oil Consumption Database, not later than one month after the issuance of Statements of Compliance.
- IV. Verify onboard, during the MARPOL VI IAPP Survey, that the SEEMP and associated Confirmation of Compliance is onboard and valid.

In the event that at the owner's request a Recognized Organisation (RO) other than the ship's Classification Society assumes responsibility for all or part of the requirement, a written agreement between the RO's concerned detailing the specific responsibilities assumed by each respective RO must be forwarded to the Administration and attached to International Air Pollution Prevention Certificate (IAPP).
